

RESOLUTION No. 28/2026
OF THE SENATE OF THE RZESZÓW UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY
of 30 April 2026

amending Resolution No. 26/2021 of the Senate of the Rzeszów University of Technology of 29 April 2021 on the adoption of the Study Regulations at the Rzeszów University of Technology.

Pursuant to Article 28(1)(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), the Senate of the Rzeszów University of Technology hereby resolves as follows:

§1

In the Study Regulations at the Rzeszów University of Technology, constituting an appendix to Resolution No. 26/2021 of the Senate of the Rzeszów University of Technology of 29 April 2021 on the adoption of the Study Regulations at the Rzeszów University of Technology, the following amendments are introduced:

1) The table of contents shall read as follows:

2) in § 1(3), the wording shall be as follows:

“3. A student of another higher education institution undertaking part of the study programme at the Rzeszów University of Technology shall be subject to the provisions of these Regulations insofar as they relate to the studies undertaken by that student at the Rzeszów University of Technology. The provisions of the

preceding sentence shall apply with due regard to the rules governing international or domestic exchange.”;

3) in § 1, after paragraph 5, paragraph 5a shall be added as follows:

“5a. In individual student matters, the submission of documents in electronic form shall be permitted via the address for electronic delivery, published on the Public Information Bulletin (BIP) website of PRZ, hereinafter referred to as the ‘address for electronic delivery’.”;

4) in § 1(8)(14), the wording shall be as follows:

“14) **thematic block (specialisation)** – an organised set of courses or groups of courses constituting a specific learning pathway, the nature of which is defined in the name of the thematic block (specialisation);”;

5) in § 1(8)(28), the wording shall be as follows:

“28) student ID card – a document issued in the form of an electronic mobile document operated via a service made available in the mObywatel application, hereinafter referred to as the ‘mStudent ID card’, or in the form of an electronic chip card, hereinafter referred to as the ‘electronic student ID card’.”;

6) in § 4, after paragraph 6, paragraph 7 shall be added as follows:

“7. The Student Rights Ombudsperson shall safeguard the rights and obligations of students specified in these Regulations and in other provisions applicable at the University.”;

7) in § 4, after paragraph 7, paragraph 8 shall be added as follows:

“8. The scope and manner of operation of the Student Rights Ombudsperson shall be determined by the Rector by way of an order.”;

8) in § 5, after paragraph 2, paragraph 2a shall be added as follows:

“2a. Where the study programme is conducted in Polish, only elective courses or courses conducted in parallel in Polish may be delivered in a foreign language.”;

9) in § 10(1), the wording shall be as follows:

“1. A person admitted to studies shall commence studies and acquire student rights upon taking the oath, the wording of which is specified in the Statutes. A person admitted to studies shall confirm taking the oath by signing the oath document. The oath shall also be taken by a person resuming studies and by a person admitted by way of transfer from another higher education institution, including a foreign one.”;

10)in § 10(3), the wording shall be as follows:

“3. Upon taking the oath, the student shall receive a student ID card. The validity of the student ID card shall be confirmed each semester: in the case of the mStudent ID card, by downloading a new QR code/activation code from the USOSweb system or the Mobile USOS application and subsequently scanning it in the mObywatel application; in the case of the electronic card, the extension shall be carried out at the dean’s office of the relevant faculty.”;

11)in § 10(5), the wording shall be as follows:

“5. In the event of damage to or loss of the electronic student ID card, the student shall be obliged to immediately notify the dean’s office of the relevant faculty. In the event of loss of the mStudent ID card, the student shall be obliged to invalidate it via the USOSweb system or the Mobile USOS application.”;

12)in § 11(1), point 19 shall be repealed;

13)in § 12(5), the wording shall be as follows:

“5. The manner of adapting and properly implementing the teaching process to the specific needs of a student with disabilities, including the conditions for undertaking studies according to the type of disability, shall be determined by the Dean or the relevant Vice-Dean.”;

14)in § 13(1)(4), the wording shall be as follows:

“4) accessing, via the individual student account in USOS and the student email account, the results of course credits and examinations, as well as other information published therein;”;

15)in § 13(2), the wording shall be as follows:

“2. At the request of the Dean, the student shall be obliged to provide a current certificate from an occupational health physician confirming the absence of contraindications to studying in a given field of study.”;

16)in § 16, after paragraph 3, paragraph 3a shall be added as follows:

“3a. In justified cases, in particular resulting from the academic calendar in a given academic year, it shall be permissible to organise a session of part-time studies before the commencement of the academic year referred to in paragraph 1.”;

17)in § 20(1), point 9 shall be repealed;

18)in § 23(6), the wording shall be as follows:

“6. In justified cases, the Rector may waive the rule set out in paragraph 5 and

grant consent for a transfer or change of field of study; however, in the case of transfer to another higher education institution, consent shall be granted by the Dean.”;

19)in § 23(7), the wording shall be as follows:

“7. A transfer or change of field of study shall be made at the student’s request, submitted no later than 2 weeks before the commencement of the semester.”;

20)in § 23, after paragraph 7, paragraph 7a shall be added as follows:

“7a. In the case of students transferring within the Rzeszów University of Technology, together with the application referred to in paragraph 7, the student shall submit documentation of the course of studies completed in another field of study at Rzeszów University of Technology, certified by the dean’s office of the faculty which the student is leaving.”;

21)in § 23, after paragraph 7a, paragraph 7b shall be added as follows:

“7b. A student of another higher education institution, together with the application referred to in paragraph 7, shall be required to attach the consent of the Dean and a current certificate confirming student status at the home institution, as well as documents certifying the course of studies completed to date, and, in the case of applying for admission to the first semester of first-cycle studies, a copy of the secondary school leaving certificate.”;

22)in § 23(8), the wording shall be as follows:

“8. In justified cases, the Dean or the Rector, as appropriate, may waive the rule set out in paragraph 7 and decide on a transfer within 2 weeks from the commencement of classes in a given semester, provided that the application for transfer was submitted within 2 weeks from the commencement of classes in that semester.”;

23)in § 24(3), the wording shall be as follows:

“3. The decision on transfer and recognition of ECTS credits shall be taken by the Dean of the receiving faculty at the student’s request, after reviewing the documentation submitted by the student concerning the course of studies completed in another field of study at Rzeszów University of Technology or at another higher education institution. The Dean of the faculty may request an opinion from the course coordinator.”;

24)in § 26(1a), the wording shall be as follows:

“1a. Re-enrolment in the same field of study, level or profile of study, including its

different modes, shall not be permitted where, on the date of enrolment, the candidate holds the status of a student or a person entered on the list of students.”;

25) in § 33, after paragraph 6, paragraph 6a shall be added as follows:

“6a. Where the academic teacher conducting classes or an examination fails to meet the deadlines referred to in paragraph 6, the student may report this fact to the Vice-Dean; where the person conducting the course credit or examination is the Vice-Dean or the Dean, the matter shall be reported to the Dean or the Vice-Rector for Education, respectively.”;

26) in § 35(1), the wording shall be as follows:

“1. The student shall be obliged to obtain course credits for all classes in a given semester provided for in the study programme before the commencement of the main examination session. With the consent of the Dean, the student may obtain course credits by the end of the main examination session. In exceptional cases, the Dean may grant consent for course credits to be obtained by the end of the resit examination session.”;

27) in § 36(6), the wording shall be as follows:

“6. A board course credit shall be conducted before a board appointed by the Dean. The board shall consist of a chairperson and two members appointed by the Dean from among academic teachers who are specialists in the subject of the classes for which the board course credit is conducted. In justified cases, the Dean may appoint additional persons to the board. The academic teacher who awarded the contested grade shall participate in the board course credit as an observer without the right to vote.”;

28) in § 36(8), the wording shall be as follows:

“8. The grade obtained in the board course credit shall be the final grade for the class, provided that a positive grade constitutes formal confirmation of passing the class.”;

29) in § 38(3), the wording shall be as follows:

“3. A board examination shall be conducted before a board appointed by the Dean. The examination board shall consist of the Dean or the Vice-Dean as chairperson and two members appointed by the Dean from among academic teachers who are specialists in the subject of the classes for which the board examination is conducted. In justified cases, the Dean may appoint additional

persons to the board. The academic teacher who awarded the contested grade shall participate in the board examination as an observer without the right to vote. The examiner and the form of the board examination shall be determined by the chairperson of the board and communicated to the student at least 3 days before the date of the examination.”;

30) in § 38, after paragraph 3, paragraph 3a shall be added as follows:

“3a. A board examination shall be conducted within 14 days from the end of the resit examination session, in accordance with the detailed organisation of the academic year.”;

31) in § 38(5), the wording shall be as follows:

“5. The grade obtained in the board examination shall be the final grade for the class, provided that a positive grade constitutes formal confirmation of passing the examination.”;

32) in § 41, after paragraph 9, paragraph 9a shall be added as follows:

“9a. At the student’s request, the dean’s office shall issue the student with a transcript of records certified by the Dean, containing, inter alia, a list of completed classes together with the number of ECTS credits assigned to those classes and the grades obtained.”;

33) in § 43(1), the wording shall be as follows:

“1. In the event of failure to complete classes in a given semester, the student may apply to repeat them within the time limit specified by the Dean.”;

34) in § 45, paragraph 5 shall be repealed;

35) in § 49(2), the wording shall be as follows:

“2. At the justified request of the student, the Dean may grant consent for the submission of the diploma thesis after the deadline specified in paragraph 1, however not later than 30 September of a given academic year. In the event of an extension of the deadline for submission of the diploma thesis, the student may be re-registered in the USOS system for the final stage of studies in the subsequent teaching cycle. Registration shall take place with a credit deficit corresponding to the number of ECTS credits assigned to the diploma thesis. In the case of studies ending in the winter semester of a given academic year, the student may complete the deficit referred to in the preceding sentence in the summer semester of that academic year.”

§ 2

The remaining provisions of the Study Regulations at the Rzeszów University of Technology shall remain unchanged.

§ 3

A consolidated text of the Study Regulations at the Rzeszów University of Technology is hereby announced, constituting an appendix to Resolution No. 26/2021 of the Senate of the Rzeszów University of Technology of 29 April 2021 on the adoption of the Study Regulations at the Rzeszów University of Technology, and forming an appendix to this Resolution.
